

Section 2. Reimbursement shall be made from any funds available for that purpose and shall be made in an amount not to exceed one-half of the total expended from any county treasury for such purposes of eradication or control.

Reimbursement to be partial only.

Section 3. All acts and parts of acts are hereby repealed in so far as they are inconsistent with the provisions of this act.

Inconsistent acts repealed.

AN ACT

To further amend the act, approved the twenty-fifth day of June, one thousand nine hundred forty-seven (Pamphlet Laws 972), entitled "An act relating to the annual salaries of certain county officers of counties of the fifth class," by increasing the salaries of jury commissioners.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Fifth class counties.

Section 1. So much as relates to salaries of jury commissioners of section 1 of the act, approved the twenty-fifth day of June, one thousand nine hundred forty-seven (Pamphlet Laws 972), entitled "An act relating to the annual salaries of certain county officers of counties of the fifth class," as last amended by the act, approved the eleventh day of October, one thousand nine hundred fifty-one (Pamphlet Laws 1702), is hereby further amended to read as follows:

So much as relates to salaries of jury commissioners of section 1, act of June 25, 1947, P. L. 972, as last amended by act of October 11, 1951, P. L. 1702, further amended.

Section 1. The annual salaries of the following county officers of counties of the fifth class shall be as follows:

Salaries of county officers.

* * * * *

The jury commissioners, [three hundred fifteen dollars (\$315.00)] *five hundred fifty dollars (\$550.00)*, each.
