## AN ACT

Amending the act of June twenty-four, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one (Pamphlet Laws 1206), entitled "An act concerning townships of the first class; amending, revising, consolidating, and changing the law relating thereto," authorizing the appointment of special police and defining their powers and duties.

"The First Class Township Code."

Section 1416, act of June 24, 1931, P. L. 1206, added May 10, 1951, P. L. 285, further amended.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section one thousand four hundred sixteen, act of June twenty-four, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one (Pamphlet Laws 1206), known as "The First Class Township Code," added May ten, one thousand nine hundred fifty-one (Pamphlet Laws 285), is amended to read:

Section 1416. Special ([School] Police.—The board of township commissioners, by resolution, may appoint special [school] police who shall have the duty of controlling and directing traffic at or near schools *and churches*, and who shall be in uniform and shall display a badge or other sign of authority, and who shall be vested with all of the powers of local police officers. Such police shall serve at the pleasure of the board of township commissioners and shall not come within the civil service provisions of this act.

## AN ACT

Amending the act of May four, one thousand nine hundred twenty-seven (Pamphlet Laws 519), entitled "An act concerning boroughs, and revising, amending, and consolidating the law relating to boroughs," authorizing payment for certain improvements in monthly instalments.

"The Borough Code".

Sections 1775 and 1779, act of May 4, 1927, P. L. 519, reenacted, revised and amended July 10, 1947, P. L. 1621, further amended.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Sections one thousand seven hundred seventy-five and one thousand seven hundred seventy-nine, act of May four, one thousand nine hundred twenty-seven (Pamphlet Laws 519), known as "The Borough Code," reenacted, revised and amended July ten, one thousand nine hundred forty-seven (Pamphlet Laws 1621), are amended to read:

Section 1775. Ordinances for Instalment Payments.—When any borough shall authorize the grading, sub-grading, or the permanent paving and improvement, of
