AN ACT

Amending the act of June ten, one thousand eight hundred ninety-seven (Pamphlet Laws 139, No. 115), entitled "An act to limit the period of time within which suits may be brought against sureties of constables," providing that suits on constables' bonds shall be brought within six years from time at which cause of action arose.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section one, act of June ten, one thousand eight hundred ninety-seven (Pamphlet Laws 139, No. 115), entitled "An act to limit the period of time within which suits may be brought against sureties of constables," is amended to read:

Section 1. Be it enacted, &c., That suits against sureties [in constables bond] *on constables' bonds* shall not be sustained, unless the same *shall* be instituted within [five] *six* years [after the date of such bond or obligation] *to be computed from the time at which the cause of action shall have accrued.*

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
