

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: The Third Class City Code.

Section 1. Clause 38 of section 2403, act of June 23, 1931 (P. L. 932), known as "The Third Class City Code," reenacted and amended June 28, 1951 (P. L. 662), is amended to read: Clause 38, section 2403, act of June 23, 1931, P. L. 932, reenacted and amended June 28, 1951, P. L. 662, further amended.

Section 2403. Specific Powers.—In addition to other powers granted by this act, the council of each city shall have power, by ordinance:

* * * * *

38. Lands for Armory Purposes.—To acquire, by purchase or by gift, or by the right of eminent domain, any land for the use of the National Guard of Pennsylvania; and to convey such lands so acquired to the Commonwealth in order to assist the Armory Board in the erection of armories. The power conferred by this clause shall not be exercised to take any church property, grave-yard, or cemetery. *Lands within three miles outside the limits of the city may be acquired in like manner for the use of the National Guard.*

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately. Act effective immediately.

AN ACT

Amending the act of August 9, 1955 (P. L. 312), entitled "An act fixing the salary of the district attorney of Philadelphia," raising the salary of the district attorney of Philadelphia.

Section 1. Section 1, act of August 9, 1955 (P. L. 312), entitled "An act fixing the salary of the district attorney of Philadelphia," is amended to read: Section 1, act of August 9, 1955, P. L. 312, amended.

Section 1. The annual salary of the district attorney of Philadelphia shall be [eighteen thousand five hundred dollars (\$18,500)] *twenty-two thousand five hundred dollars (\$22,500)*.
