

authorized to appoint and set the salaries of stenographers and clerks provided the cost of such help shall not exceed the sum of [five thousand six hundred dollars (\$5600)] *six thousand seven hundred dollars (\$6700)* per annum for each of said judges. Such salaries shall be paid by the Commonwealth.

Act effective immediately.

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

AN ACT

Amending the act of June 3, 1937 (P. L. 1225), entitled "An act concerning game and other wild birds and wild animals; and amending, revising, consolidating, and changing the law relating thereto," limiting the number of persons who may hunt deer in unison or as a party.

The Game Law.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 707, act of June 3, 1937, P. L. 1225, amended by adding a new subsection (1).

Section 1. Section 707, act of June 3, 1937 (P. L. 1225), known as "The Game Law," is amended by adding, at the end thereof, a new subsection to read:

Section 707. Regulations for Parties Hunting Big Game.—

* * * * *

(i) No group hunting deer together or in unison or as a party, shall consist of more than twenty-five persons.

Act effective immediately.

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

Amending the act of May 1, 1933 (P. L. 103), entitled "An act concerning townships of the second class; and amending, revising, consolidating, and changing the law relating thereto," authorizing disturbing the peace to be defined and penalized, and providing for disposition of such penalties.

The Second Class Township Code.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:
