AN ACT

Amending the act of July 28, 1953 (P. L. 723), entitled "An act relating to counties of the second class; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," empowering the exercise of eminent domain for certain purposes in regard to graveyards and cemeteries.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 2602,

Section 1. Section 2602, act of July 28, 1953 (P. L. 723), known as the "Second Class County Code," is amended to read:

Section 2602. Certain Property Not to be Taken by Eminent Domain.—The power conferred by this article shall not be exercised to enter upon, appropriate, take, injure or destroy any church property, graveyard or cemetery, *except for the purposes and subject to the provisions of the act of May 12, 1887 (P. L. 96).*

Act effective
immediately.

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
