AN ACT

Amending the act of June 3, 1937 (P. L. 1225), entitled "An act concerning game and other wild birds and wild animals; and amending, revising, consolidating, and changing the law relating thereto," providing authority for the Game Commission to prescribe the type of firearms, bow and arrow and type of ammunition to be used in any designated area.

The Game Law.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 703, act of June 3, 1937, P. L. 1225, amended by adding a new clause (f).

Section 1. Section 703, act of June 3, 1937 (P. L. 1225), known as "The Game Law," is amended by adding, after clause (e), a new clause to read:

Section 703. Lawful Methods of Hunting.—It is lawful to hunt for, catch, take, wound or kill game of any kind only through the use of a gun, pistol, revolver, or bow and arrow, of a kind the use of which is not hereinafter prohibited, except:

* * * * *

Type of firearm, bow and arrow and ammunition to be prescribed.

(f) *That the commission may, by resolution, prescribe the type of firearms or bow and arrow and the type of ammunition to be used in any designated area of the Commonwealth in the interest of public safety and the proper management of game birds and game animals. Such action as taken by the commission shall be advertised as provided in section 505 of this act.*
