AN ACT

Providing for the acquisition by the Department of Forests and Waters of the Kinzua Bridge and certain adjoining grounds for a State park, and making an appropriation.

Bridges.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Department of Forests and Waters authorized to acquire land and Kinzua Bridge, in McKean County.

Section 1. The Department of Forests and Waters is hereby authorized to acquire by gift, purchase or condemnation proceedings, the Kinzua Bridge and such adjoining grounds in McKean County, Pennsylvania, as the Secretary of Forests and Waters may deem necessary.

The bridge and grounds shall be preserved and maintained as a State park and be known as the *Kinzua Bridge State Park.

Title approval by Department of Justice before acquisition.

Section 2. The title of the real estate shall be taken in the name of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and shall, before its acquisition, be approved by the Department of Justice.

Appropriation.

Section 3. The sum of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000), or as much thereof as is necessary, is hereby appropriated for the purpose of carrying out the provisions of this act.

AN ACT

Amending the act of May 31, 1957 (P. L. 212), entitled "An act authorizing the Pennsylvania Fish Commission, with the approval of the Governor, to convey 78.841 acres of land, con-

taining a body of water thereon known as Silver Lake, situate in the Borough of Bristol and Township of Bristol and County of Bucks, for use as a public lake, fishing and recreation area," authorizing the Pennsylvania Fish Commission, with the approval of the Governor, to convey its reversionary interest in a certain tract of ground in Bucks County and to release the property from certain restrictions imposed.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Real property.

Section 1. The act of May 31, 1957 (P. L. 212), entitled "An act authorizing the Pennsylvania Fish Commission, with the approval of the Governor, to convey 78.841 acres of land, containing a body of water thereon known as Silver Lake, situate in the Borough of Bristol and Township of Bristol and County of Bucks, for use as a public lake, fishing and recreation area," is amended by adding, after section 3 a new section to read:

Act of May 31, 1957, P. L. 212, amended by adding a new section 3.1.

Section 3.1. The Pennsylvania Fish Commission, acting on behalf of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, with the approval of the Governor, is authorized and directed to convey to the County of Bucks, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, for the consideration of one dollar (\$1), its reversionary interest in all that certain parcel of land, situate in the Township of Bristol, County of Bucks and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, bounded and described as follows, to wit:

Conveyance of reversionary interest in land located in Bristol Township, Bucks County, authorized.

Beginning at a point on the westerly side of Legislative Route 152 in line of lands of the Bucks County Park Board; thence along the westerly required right-of-way of said Legislative Route 152 south 6 degrees 48 minutes east 11.50 feet to a point; thence still by same south 10 degrees 46 minutes 20 seconds west 42.38 feet to a point; thence still by same south 0 degrees 5 minutes 21 seconds west 45 feet to a point of curve; thence still by same on a curve to the left having a radius of 297 feet an arc length of 75 feet to a point of tangent; thence still by same south 14 degrees 22 minutes 47 seconds east 25 feet to a point of curve; thence still by same on a curve to the left having a radius of 211 feet an arc length of 50 feet to a point of tangent; thence still by same south 27 degrees 57 minutes 25 seconds east 50 feet to a corner; thence still by same north 71 degrees 02 minutes 35 seconds east 10 feet to a point; thence still by same on a curve to the left having a radius of 1176.28 feet an arc length of 61.96 feet to a point of tangent; thence still by same south 21 degrees 58 minutes 30 seconds east 84.18 feet to a point in line of lands of the Bucks County Park Board; thence along lands of the Borough of Bristol north 73 degrees 09 minutes west 257.36 feet to a point; thence still by same north 11 degrees 12 minutes east 219.07 feet to the point and

place of beginning, containing 0.25 acre, more or less, and being a portion of the premises conveyed under the provisions of section 1 of this act.

Release authorized.

Section 2. In and for the same consideration, the Pennsylvania Fish Commission is further authorized to release the property described in section 3.1 from the restrictions imposed by section 3 hereof and the conveyance made pursuant to this act.

Approval and execution.

Section 3. The deed of conveyance and the release of restrictions shall be approved by the Department of Justice and shall be executed by the Executive Director of the Pennsylvania Fish Commission in the name of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

Act effective immediately.

Section 4. This act shall take effect immediately.

AN ACT

Providing for the observance of October 12 of each year as Columbus Day.

Proclamation.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Governor to issue annually Proclamation designating October 12, Columbus Day.

Section 1. The Governor shall issue, annually, his Proclamation designating and setting apart October 12 as Columbus Day, and calling upon the people of the Commonwealth, the public schools and other educational institutions and historical organizations to observe the discovery of the New World with appropriate exercises and programs, to the end that the discovery of America shall be commemorated each year.

Act effective immediately.

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

Amending the act of June 24, 1939 (P. L. 872), entitled "An act to consolidate, amend and revise the penal laws of the Commonwealth," authorizing the County Treasurer to retain the fee for the issuance of firearms' licenses.
