AN ACT

Amending the act of June 1, 1933 (P. L. 1172), entitled "An act establishing certain streets in boroughs and incorporated towns as State highways, and providing for their construction and maintenance at the expense of the Commonwealth," changing or deleting certain routes and adding certain new routes.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: State highways.

Section 1. The following routes established by section 2, act of June 1, 1933 (P. L. 1172), entitled "An act establishing certain streets in boroughs and incorporated towns as State highways, and providing for their construction and maintenance at the expense of the Commonwealth," and its amendments are deleted as indicated or amended to read:

Routes as stated in section 2, act of June 1, 1933, P. L. 1172, as amended, deleted or further amended.

[Route 43126. Beginning at a point on State Highway Route 238, Main Street in the Borough of Greenville, at the intersection of Race Street and Main Street; thence

north to the intersection of Race Street and Alan Avenue; thence easterly over Alan Avenue to an intersection with Legislative Route 82, College Street, a distance of approximately .7 of a mile in Greenville Borough, Mercer County.]

Various public highways in boroughs adopted as State highways.

Section 2. All or part of the following various public highways, or sections thereof, bridges, tunnels, viaducts and approaches thereto, in boroughs, shall, if and when the borough council consents thereto by resolution a copy of which shall be filed in the office of the clerk of the courts of the proper county and with the Department of Highways, be adopted by the Commonwealth as a State highway, and shall thereafter be maintained, repaired and constructed in the same manner with like power and authority as provided by the laws of the Commonwealth applicable to State highways; however, no highway, bridge, viaduct or approach thereto shall be taken over by the Commonwealth under the provisions of this act if a contract for the improvement thereof has been entered into between a contractor and the Commonwealth, or local authorities, or both, until such contract shall have been completed.

AN ACT

Amending the act of May 29, 1931 (P.
