

[Deputy Commissioner of the Pennsylvania State Police, thirteen thousand five hundred dollars (\$13,500).]

Secretary of Labor and Industry, twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000).

Secretary of Public Welfare, twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000).

Secretary of Revenue, twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000).

Secretary of Commerce, twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000).

Neither the Governor, Lieutenant Governor nor the head of any Administrative Department shall receive any additional compensation for any services rendered to the Commonwealth in any capacity.

Section 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

AN ACT

SB 454

Amending the act of June 1, 1933 (P. L. 1172), entitled "An act establishing certain streets in boroughs and incorporated towns as State highways, and providing for their construction and maintenance at the expense of the Commonwealth," deleting a route in Mercer County.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Route 43068, established by the act of June 1, 1933 (P. L. 1172), entitled "An act establishing certain streets in boroughs and incorporated towns as State highways, and providing for their construction and maintenance at the expense of the Commonwealth," and its amendments, is deleted as follows:

Sandy Lake Borough

[Route 43068. Extending Route 43068.—Beginning at a point on the Sandy Lake Borough-Sandy Lake Township line, thence in a southeasterly direction on the Sandy Creek Road to an intersection with Route 294, at Sandy Creek Road and Main Street, in the borough of Sandy Lake, Mercer County, a distance of about .03 of a mile.]

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
