

as a State employe, and (c) the supplemental State annuity shall not exceed two thousand six hundred dollars (\$2,600) per year.

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately and shall be applicable from August 31, 1967.

AN ACT

HB 65

Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P. L. 30), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain provisions applicable as well to private and parochial schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," changing the time limitation on the conveyance of property to historical societies.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Clause ¹ (10) of section 707, act of March 10, 1949 (P. L. 30), known as the "Public School Code of 1949," added July 31, 1963 (P. L. 404), is amended to read:

Section 707. Sale of Unused and Unnecessary Lands and Buildings.—The board of school directors of any district is hereby vested with the necessary power and authority to sell unused and unnecessary lands and buildings, by any of the following methods and subject to the following provisions:

* * *

(10) Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this section, any school district may, at any time prior to [July 1, 1965,] July 1, 1969, convey any unused and unnecessary lands and buildings which are of historical significance and importance to any legally constituted historical society for historical purposes without consideration or for such consideration and on such terms or exchange or otherwise as may be agreed upon without complying with the other provisions of this section.

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
