

to the department and to the Department of the Auditor General for audit. Upon the failure of the county commissioners to file any one of such reports, or to make any payments, allocations or expenditures, in compliance with the provisions of this section, the department shall withhold further payments to the county out of the Liquid Fuels Tax Fund until the delinquent report is filed, transmitted, or said moneys allocated, or said expenditures for the prior six months are approved by the Department of Highways.

\* \* \*

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

SB 86

Amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P. L. 177), entitled "An act providing for and reorganizing the conduct of the executive and administrative work of the Commonwealth by the Executive Department thereof and the administrative departments, boards, commissions, and officers thereof, including the boards of trustees of State Normal Schools, or Teachers Colleges; abolishing, creating, reorganizing or authorizing the reorganization of certain administrative departments, boards and commissions; defining the powers and duties of the Governor and other executive and administrative officers, and of the several administrative departments, boards, commissions, and officers; fixing the salaries of the Governor, Lieutenant Governor, and certain other executive and administrative officers; providing for the appointment of certain administrative officers, and of all deputies and other assistants and employes in certain departments, boards, and commissions; and prescribing the manner in which the number and compensation of the deputies and all other assistants and employes of certain departments, boards and commissions shall be determined," requiring the display of signs on road building equipment rented by the Department of Highways.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 2003, act of April 9, 1929 (P. L. 177), known as "The Administrative Code of 1929," is amended by adding after clause (f), a new clause to read:

Section 2003. Machinery, Equipment, Lands and Buildings.—The Department of Highways shall have the power, and its duty shall be:

\* \* \*

(f.1) To cause to be displayed on every piece of road building equipment rented by the department a sign indicating such rental. The department shall furnish such sign in every case to the con-

tractor operating the equipment and the sign shall be displayed by the contractor at all times the equipment is being operated on a State rental reimbursement cost.

SB 281

Amending the act of June 1, 1933 (P. L. 1172), entitled "An act establishing certain streets in boroughs and incorporated towns as State highways, and providing for their construction and maintenance at the expense of the Commonwealth," deleting a route in Millersburg Borough in Dauphin County.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. The following route established by section 2, act of June 1, 1933 (P. L. 1172), entitled "An act establishing certain streets in boroughs and incorporated towns as State highways, and providing for their construction and maintenance at the expense of the Commonwealth," and its amendments is deleted as follows:

[Route 22057. Extending Route 22057.—Beginning at a point on the Millersburg Borough-Upper Paxton Township line; thence in a southerly direction to an intersection with Route 199, in the borough of Millersburg, Dauphin County, a distance of about 0.42 of a mile.]

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
