AN ACT

HB 127

Relating to the Common Pleas Court of Philadelphia.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. The Court of Common Pleas for the City and County of Philadelphia shall consist of fifty-six judges, thirty of whom shall be members of the trial division, twenty of whom shall be members of the family court division, and six of whom shall be members of the orphans' court division. The aforesaid complement of judges shall exist exclusive of any judge or judges who have been declared permanently disabled or infirm in accordance with the act of October 19, 1967 (Act No. 209).

The president judge shall have the power to assign judges from each division to each other division of the court when required to expedite the business of the court: Provided however, That judges so assigned from one division to another division of the court shall nonetheless remain members of their original division.

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
