Authorizing the Water and Power Resources Board to grant an easement across Shamokin Island, in the Borough of Duboistown, Lycoming County, for electric public utility transmission line purposes.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. The Water and Power Resources Board is hereby authorized to grant to Pennsylvania Power and Light Company, an electric public utility organized under the laws of the Commonwealth with principal offices at Allentown, Lehigh County, its successors and assigns, an easement of such width and for such consideration as the board shall determine, across Shamokin Island, sometimes called Schuman Island in the Susquehanna River in the Borough of Duboistown, Lycoming County, for the construction, use, operation, maintenance, replacement and removal of a tower, double circuit line and associated facilities for transmission of electric power across the Susquehanna River at that location.

Section 2. The deed granting such easement shall recite that whenever the grantee, its successors and assigns, shall permanently discontinue use of the easement for the transmission of electric power, grantee shall remove all of its facilities therefrom; and that upon such removal, the easement granted by said deed shall terminate.

Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
