AN ACT

SB 793

Amending the act of June 22, 1931 (P. L. 594), entitled "An act establishing certain township roads as State highways; authorizing their construction, maintenance, and improvement under certain conditions and restrictions; limiting the obligation of the Commonwealth in the construction of certain structures located on such highways; conferring certain powers upon the Department of Highways and local authorities, persons, associations and corporations for sharing the cost of the maintenance and construction of such highways; and making an appropriation to carry out the provisions of said act," changing a route and deleting a route in Armstrong County.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. The following routes established by the act of June 22, 1931 (P. L. 594), entitled "An act establishing certain township roads as State highways; authorizing their construction, maintenance, and improvement under certain conditions and restrictions; limiting the obligation of the Commonwealth in the construction of certain structures located on such highways; conferring certain powers upon the Department of Highways and local authorities, persons, associations and corporations for sharing the cost of the maintenance and construction of such highways; and making an appropriation to carry out the provisions of said act," are amended or deleted to read as follows:

Route 03057. Beginning at [William McIntyre's on the Elderton-Sagamore Road:] *a point on Legislative Route 03055* and extending in an easterly direction in Plum Creek Township, along Plum Creek *South Branch*, through crossroads at Elmer Kimmel's, to a point on the Armstrong-Indiana County line, in Armstrong County, a distance of about [2.8] *2.65* miles.

[Route 03063. Beginning at a point on the Atwood Borough line; thence extending in a northwesterly direction to Sloan's Crossroads in Cowanshannock Township; thence northerly to an intersection with Route 189 at Meredith, in Armstrong County, a distance of about 3.6 miles.]

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
