## AN ACT

HB 2388

Amending the act of March 27, 1929 (P.L.84), entitled, as amended, "An act to fix the fees to be charged by coroners in counties of the second and second A class," charging a certain fee.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

- Section 1. Section 1, act of March 27, 1929 (P.L.84), entitled, as amended, "An act to fix the fees to be charged by coroners in counties of the second and second A class," amended January 26, 1956 (P.L.947) and December 14, 1967 (P.L.855), is amended to read:
- Section 1. Be it enacted, &c., That from and after the passage of this act the fees to be received and charged by coroners in counties of the second and second A class in lieu of those now allowed by law shall be as follows, viz:

Viewing a dead body, [fifteen dollars (\$15.00)] seventy-five dollars (\$75.00).

Summoning inquest and returning inquisition, eight dollars (\$8.00).

Summoning or subpoening each witness, three dollars and fifty cents (\$3.50).

Qualifying each witness, two dollars and fifty cents (\$2.50).

Each mile circular traveled to be reckoned from the court house to the place of viewing the body, ten cents.
