HB 201

Amending the act of March 13, 1815 (P.L.150), entitled "An act concerning divorces," regulating the legitimacy of certain children.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section IX, act of March 13, 1815 (P.L.150), entitled "An act concerning divorces," is amended to read:

Section IX. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, That the husband or wife, who shall have been guilty of the crime of adultery, shall not marry the person with whom the said crime was committed, during the life of the former wife or husband: but nothing herein contained shall be construed to extend to or affect or render **[illegitimate] other than legitimate** any children born of the body of the wife during coverture.
