Amending the act of June 3, 1937 (P.L.1225), entitled "An act concerning game and other wild birds and wild animals; and amending, revising, consolidating, and changing the law relating thereto," increasing the maximum purchase price per acre the commission may pay for land exclusive of Federal and other cost-sharing funds.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. The first paragraph of section 903, act of June 3, 1937 (P.L.1225), known as "The Game Law," amended May 24, 1956 (P.L.1736), is amended to read:

Section 903. Purchase Price.—For land to be used as State Game Lands the commission may pay what it considers a fair and reasonable price not exceeding one hundred dollars per acre *exclusive of Federal and other cost-sharing funds* and consistent with the market value of land in the locality in which any such land may be located.

* * *

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
