Providing that the term "veteran" used in acts of the General Assembly includes those who have served in the armed forces of the United States in the Vietnam Conflict.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Wherever the term "veteran" appears in any act of the General Assembly concerning service in the armed forces of the United States the construction thereof shall include those who have served in the Vietnam Conflict.
