AN ACT

HB 6

Authorizing the Governor to allocate funds necessary to provide for the repair or replacement of volunteer fire company and ambulance association equipment and facilities damaged or destroyed in the great storms and floods of September, 1971 and June, 1972.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. The Governor is hereby authorized to allocate from funds appropriated under the act of July 7, 1972 (Act No. 18-A), as much money as may be necessary to provide for the repair or replacement of volunteer fire company and ambulance association operational equipment and facilities damaged or destroyed in the great storms and floods of September, 1971 and June, 1972.

Section 2. Such funds as may be allocated by the Governor shall not be used for the repair or replacement of meeting halls, social rooms or any other facilities not directly related to fire fighting, rescue or ambulance operations.

Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
