## AN ACT

HB 916

Amending the act of April 29, 1959 (P.L.58, No.32), entitled "An act consolidating and revising the Vehicle Code, the Tractor Code, the Motor Vehicle Financial Responsibility Act and other acts relating to the ownership, possession and use of vehicles and tractors," further regulating the reporting of payments.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Subsection (b) of section 1301, act of April 29, 1959 (P.L.58, No.32), known as "The Vehicle Code," is amended to read:

Section 1301. Disposition of Fines and Forfeitures.—

\* \* \*

(b) [Sworn statements] Reports of all fines and penalties so collected and all bail forfeited shall also be made by the magistrate or other officer, imposing or receiving the same, to the secretary upon forms furnished by the department. Such reports shall be made monthly not later than the [tenth] thirtieth day of the following month.

Penalty.—Any magistrate or other officer, who shall fail to make such monthly reports and returns, or either of them, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor in office, and upon conviction thereof in a court of quarter sessions, shall be sentenced to pay a fine of five hundred dollars (\$500.00) and costs of prosecution, or undergo imprisonment for not more than sixty (60) days, or suffer both such fine and imprisonment.
