Amending the act of December 6, 1972 (P.L.1376, No.292), entitled "An act to provide for the selection of jurors to serve in the court of common pleas of counties of the second class; defining the qualifications of such jurors; providing for the organization of a commission for the selection of jurors in such counties, and prescribing its powers and duties; and repealing inconsistent acts," further providing for an effective date.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 21, act of December 6, 1972 (P.L.1376, No.292), known as the "Second Class County Jury Selection Act," is amended to read:

Section 21. Effective Date.—This act shall take effect [January 1, following its enactment but it shall not become effective within less than eleven months following such enactment] July 1, 1974: Provided, further, That encumbent commissioners shall continue in service until successors are duly qualified.

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
