## AN ACT

**HB 140** 

Amending the act of March 4, 1970 (P.L.128, No.49), entitled "An act granting to the Governor of the Commonwealth the sole authority for regulating the display of the flag of the United States from any public ground or building and from any ground or building of certain other institutions," further providing for the display of the United States flag.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 1, act of March 4, 1970 (P.L.128, No.49), entitled "An act granting to the Governor of the Commonwealth the sole authority for regulating the display of the flag of the United States from any public ground or building and from any ground or building of certain other institutions," is amended to read:

- Section 1. (a) The Governor of the Commonwealth shall have the sole power and duty for regulating the display of the flag of the United States from any public ground or building of the Commonwealth, of any board, commission or authority of the Commonwealth created by the General Assembly, of any political subdivision of the Commonwealth, of any school district of the Commonwealth, or from any ground or building of any institution which receives any State aid from the Commonwealth. The Governor shall have the power and duty to promulgate rules and regulations pursuant to the provisions of this section and such rules and regulations shall be in compliance with the National Flag Code.
- (b) Notwithstanding any of the provisions of this section, the United States flag shall be displayed daily, except during inclement weather, at all educational institutions of higher learning which are State-owned or receive State aid from the Commonwealth.

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
