Amending the act of May 16, 1929 (P.L.1784, No.587), entitled "An act concerning newspapers; creating uniformity in the publication of legal notices and advertisements; defining the newspapers in which official and legal advertising shall be published; prescribing methods for computing the charges therefor, and providing that the expenses for publishing legal advertising or notices shall be taxable and collectible as court costs are now taxed and collected in all matters and proceedings," providing for use of common, local or general usage designations in certain cases of official or legal advertising.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. The act of May 16, 1929 (P.L.1784, No.587), known as the "Newspaper Advertising Act," is amended by adding a section to read:

Section 7.1. Whenever official advertising or legal advertising involves a road, street, highway, bridge, municipality, village or boundary, the advertising shall, in order that it may readily be understood by the people of the area involved, include the common, local or general usage designation of every such road, street, highway, bridge, municipality, village or boundary. The application of common, local or general language designation used for the purpose of complying with the notice provisions of this act, if mistakenly or erroneously applied, shall not serve to invalidate any matter or proceeding which has in all other respects been properly and lawfully executed.
