Repealing the act of May 26, 1943 (P.L.607, No.264), entitled "An act authorizing administrative boards within the Department of Public Instruction, for the duration of the present War, to admit to examination and grant licenses or registration to certain applicants who are less than twenty-one, but not less than twenty years of age."

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. The act of May 26, 1943 (P.L.607, No.264), entitled "An act authorizing administrative boards within the Department of Public Instruction, for the duration of the present War, to admit to examination and grant licenses or registration to certain applicants who are less than twenty-one, but not less than twenty years of age," is repealed.
