Amending the act of May 28, 1915 (P.L.596, No.259), entitled "An act requiring cities of the second class to establish a pension fund for employes of said cities, and regulating the administration and the payment of such pensions," further providing for pension benefits in second class cities.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Clause (e) of section 4, act of May 28, 1915 (P.L.596, No.259), entitled "An act requiring cities of the second class to establish a pension fund for employes of said cities, and regulating the administration and the payment of such pensions," added November 2, 1973 (No.101), is amended to read:

Section 4. * * *

(e) In addition to other benefits provided by this act, city council may, by ordinance, pay beneficiaries of the fund who retired on or before [January 1, 1964] July 1, 1969 an additional sum of forty dollars (\$40) per month.
