## AN ACT

HB 2264

Amending the act of June 22, 1931 (P.L.594, No.203), entitled "An act establishing certain township roads as State highways; authorizing their construction, maintenance, and improvement under certain conditions and restrictions; limiting the obligation of the Commonwealth in the construction of certain structures located on such highways; conferring certain powers upon the Department of Highways and local authorities, persons, associations and corporations for sharing the cost of the maintenance and construction of such highways; and making an appropriation to carry out the provisions of said act," deleting a portion of a route in Beaver County.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Route 04064 in the County of Beaver in section 5, act of June 22, 1931 (P.L.594, No.203), entitled "An act establishing certain township roads as State highways; authorizing their construction, maintenance, and improvement under certain conditions and restrictions; limiting the obligation of the Commonwealth in the construction of certain structures located on such highways; conferring certain powers upon the Department of Highways and local authorities, persons, associations and corporations for sharing the cost of the maintenance and construction of such highways; and making an appropriation to carry out the provisions of said act," is amended to read:

Section 5. \*\*\*

Route 04064. [Beginning at a point on Route 115 near the bridge over Raccoon Creek; and extending along the river road to a point on the Shippingport Borough line;] Beginning at Station 119+00 on the Montgomery Dam Road thence extending in an easterly direction-to-the intersection with L.R. 115 in Potter Township, in Beaver County, a distance of about [2.2] 1.58 miles.
