## AN ACT

SB 1248

Amending the act of August 9, 1955 (P.L.323, No.130), entitled "An act relating to counties of the third, fourth, fifth, sixth, seventh and eighth classes; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," authorizing the county commissioners to enter into certain leases.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

- Section 1. Subsection (b) of section 2501, act of August 9, 1955 (P.L.323, No.130), known as "The County Code," is amended to read: Section 2501. Acquisition of Land and Buildings for Recreation Places.—\* \*
- (b) The county commissioners may also acquire for use as any such recreation place, or the extension or enlargement thereof, lands or buildings, by gift, purchase or the power of eminent domain. They may also lease lands or buildings within the county for [temporary] use for any such purpose.
