Amending the act of April 27, 1927 (P.L.465, No.299), entitled, as amended, "An act to provide for the safety of persons employed, housed, or assembled in certain buildings and structures not in cities of the first class, second class, and second class A, by requiring certain construction and ways of egress, equipment, and maintenance; providing for the licensing of projectionists, except in cities of the first class and second class; requiring the submission of plans for examination and approval; providing for the promulgation of rules and regulations for the enforcement of this act; providing for the enforcement of this act by the Department of Labor and Industry and, in certain cases, by the chiefs of fire departments in cities of the third class; providing penalties for violations of the provisions of this act; and repealing certain acts," changing the fees for approving plans.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. The second paragraph of section 8, act of April 27, 1927, (P.L.465, No.299), entitled, as amended, "An act to provide for the safety of persons employed, housed, or assembled in certain buildings and structures not in cities of the first class, second class, and second class A, by requiring certain construction and ways of egress, equipment, and maintenance; providing for the licensing of projectionists, except in cities of the first class and second class; requiring the submission of plans for examination and approval; providing for the promulgation of rules and regulations for the enforcement of this act; providing for the enforcement of this act by the Department of Labor and Industry and, in certain cases, by the chiefs of fire departments in cities of the third class; providing penalties for violations of the provisions of this act; and repealing certain acts," amended May 22, 1953 (P.L.196, No.15), is amended to read:

Section 8. Approval of Plans.—* * *

For making the necessary examination for approval of architectural drawings, specifications, or other data, the department shall make a charge equal to the actual cost of making such examinations, not, however, to exceed the sum of [seventy-five dollars (\$75.00)] five hundred dollars (\$500.00), and no such drawings, specifications, or other data shall be approved until payment is made of the fee charged therefor. All fees received by the said department for making such examinations shall be paid into the State Treasury through the Department of Revenue.

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
