AN ACT

SB 612

Amending the act of June 24, 1931 (P.L.1206, No.331), entitled "An act concerning townships of the first class; amending, revising, consolidating, and changing the law relating thereto," further providing for provisions relating to fixing the salary, compensation and emoluments of elected officers of the township.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 603, act of June 24, 1931 (P.L.1206, No.331), known as "The First Class Township Code," reenacted and amended May 27, 1949 (P.L.1955, No.569), is amended to read:

Section 603. Compensation.—**[No township shall increase or diminish the salary, compensation, or emoluments of any elected officer after his election.] Elected officers of townships shall receive such salary, compensation or emoluments of office as may from time to time be fixed by ordinance of the township in accordance with provisions of section 703. Any change in salary, compensation or emoluments of office shall become effective at the beginning of the next term of the elected officer.** Appointed officers and employes of the township shall receive such compensation for their services as the township commissioners shall prescribe.

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

We certify that this bill, Senate Bill No. 612, Printer's No. 1240, having passed both Houses, vetoed by the Governor, was returned to the Senate where the Senate proceeded to reconsider and again pass the bill by more than a two-thirds majority of the members elected to the Senate, the objections of the Governor to the contrary notwithstanding. Upon notification by the Senate as to their action the House of Representatives proceeded to reconsider and again pass the bill by more than a two-thirds majority of the members elected to the House of Representatives, the objections of the Governor to the contrary notwithstanding.
