## AN ACT

## HB 1464

Amending the act of June 1, 1933 (P.L.1172, No.290), entitled "An act establishing certain streets in boroughs and incorporated towns as State highways, and providing for their construction and maintenance at the expense of the Commonwealth," deleting a route in Hookstown Borough, Beaver County.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. The following route in section 1, act of June 1, 1933 (P.L.1172, No.290), entitled "An act establishing certain streets in boroughs and incorporated towns as State highways, and providing for their construction and maintenance at the expense of the Commonwealth," is deleted:

Section 1. Be it enacted, &c., That the following streets in boroughs or incorporated towns shall, respectively, be adopted as State highways, to be constructed and maintained at the expense of the Commonwealth under the provisions of present or future laws governing State highways in boroughs.

## Hookstown Borough

**[Route 04052. Extending Route 04052.—Beginning at a point on the Hookstown Borough-Greene Township line, thence in an easterly direction on Mill Street to an intersection with Route 278 in the borough of Hookstown, Beaver County, a distance of about .13 of a mile.]**

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Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
