## AN ACT

HB 1645

Amending the act of June 24, 1931 (P.L.1206, No.331), entitled "An act concerning townships of the first class; amending, revising, consolidating, and changing the law relating thereto," providing for an appropriation to certain tourist promotion agencies.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 1502, act of June 24, 1931 (P.L.1206, No.331), known as "The First Class Township Code," reenacted and amended May 27, 1949 (P.L.1955, No.569), is amended by adding a clause to read:

Section 1502. The corporate power of a township of the first class shall be vested in the board of township commissioners. The board shall have power—

***LXXI. Appropriations to Tourist Promotion Agencies. To appropriate annually, such amount of money but not in excess of ten cents (10¢) for each resident of the township, as determined by the latest official census, which may be deemed necessary, to any "tourist promotion agency," as defined in the act of April 28, 1961 (P.L.111, No.50), known as the "Tourist Promotion Law," to assist such agencies in carrying out tourist promotional activities.***

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
