Amending the act of June 3, 1937 (P.L.1225, No.316), entitled "An act concerning game and other wild birds and wild animals; and amending, revising, consolidating, and changing the law relating thereto," increasing the maximum purchase price per acre the commission may pay for land.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. The first paragraph of section 903, act of June 3, 1937 (P.L.1225, No.316), known as "The Game Law," amended October 26, 1972 (P.L.1019, No.248), is amended to read:

Section 903. Purchase Price.—For land to be used as State Game Lands the commission may pay what it considers a fair and reasonable price not exceeding **[one hundred dollars]** *two hundred dollars* per acre exclusive of Federal and other cost-sharing funds and consistent with the market value of land in the locality in which any such land may be located.

* * *

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
