## AN ACT

HB 1478

Amending the act of August 9, 1955 (P.L. 323, No. 130), entitled "An act relating to counties of the third, fourth, fifth, sixth, seventh and eighth classes; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," authorizing certain county officers in counties having a Home Rule Charter or optional form of government to organize State associations; and making an editorial change.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Clauses (1) and (12) of section 440, act of August 9, 1955 (P.L. 323, No. 130), known as "The County Code," added or amended August 11, 1967 (P.L. 224, No. 81) and September 1, 1967 (P.L. 289, No. 120), are amended to read:

Section 440. State Associations Authorized.—County officers of each county may organize for themselves a State association as follows:

(1) The county commissioners, together with the county solicitor and the chief clerk to the county commissioners *and certain officers who are counterpart personnel in counties having a Home Rule Charter or optional form of government.*

[(12)] (13) The county auditors.

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
