Authorizing certain uniformed boy scouts and scouters to temporarily fish in Lake Arthur pursuant to a special fishing permit.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Uniformed boy scouts and scouters who are registered participants to the 1977 National Jamboree, to be held at Moraine State Park, Butler County, Pennsylvania, from August 3, 1977 through August 9, 1977, are authorized to fish in Lake Arthur during said period pursuant to a special fishing permit to be issued by the Pennsylvania Fish Commission.

Section 2. The Pennsylvania Fish Commission is authorized to issue the special fishing permit authorized by this act without charge to said boy scouts and scouters who are registered participants to the said 1977 National Jamboree.

Section 3. Boy scouts and scouters who receive the special fishing permit shall be in their scout uniform while exercising the privilege of fishing and shall abide by all laws and regulations adopted by the Pennsylvania Fish Commission.

Section 4. This act shall take effect immediately.
