Amending the act of July 28, 1953 (P.L.676, No.210), entitled "An act providing for the observance of March fifteenth of each year as Charter Day," changing the date of the observance.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. The title and section 1, act of July 28, 1953 (P.L.676, No.210), entitled "An act providing for the observance of March fifteenth of each year as Charter Day," are amended to read:

AN ACT

Providing for the observance of March [fifteenth] fourteenth of each year as Charter Day.

Section 1. The Governor shall issue annually his Proclamation designating and setting apart March [fifteenth] fourteenth as Charter Day and calling upon the people of the Commonwealth, the public schools and other educational institutions and patriotic, religious, historical and veterans' organizations to observe the anniversary of the execution of the Royal Charter by King Charles II on the [fifteenth] fourteenth day of March, one thousand six hundred eighty-one, thereby creating the corporate legal existence of Pennsylvania, with appropriate exercises and programs, to the end that the establishment or birthday of Pennsylvania shall be commemorated each year.

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
