## AN ACT

## HB 353

Amending the act of June 19, 1953 (P.L.279, No.54), entitled "An act to prohibit operation of boats having a developed horsepower rating in excess of ten on Canadohta Lake, in Crawford County," further providing for the use of boats with motors.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. The act of June 19, 1953 (P.L.279, No.54), entitled "An act to prohibit operation of boats having a developed horsepower rating in excess of ten on Canadohta Lake, in Crawford County," is amended by adding a section to read:

Section 1.1. Any boat equipped with a motor in excess of ten horsepower rating may be operated on Canadohta Lake in Crawford County if the motor is rendered inoperable by removal of the propeller, and such propeller is left ashore. After removal of the propeller, a motor of not more than ten horsepower rating may be attached to the boat and used for propelling the boat on Canadohta Lake.

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
