## AN ACT

HB 1875

Amending the act of June 22, 1931 (P.L.594, No.203), entitled "An act establishing certain township roads as State highways; authorizing their construction, maintenance, and improvement under certain conditions and restrictions; limiting the obligation of the Commonwealth in the construction of certain structures located on such highways; conferring certain powers upon the Department of Highways and local authorities, persons, associations and corporations for sharing the cost of the maintenance and construction of such highways; and making an appropriation to carry out the provisions of said act," further providing for several routes in Montgomery County.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Routes 46086 and 46114, established by the act of June 22, 1931 (P.L.594, No.203), referred to as the Township State Highway Law, are amended as follows:

## Montgomery County

\* \* \*

Route 46086. Beginning at a point on the Philadelphia - Montgomery County line **[about .6 of a mile northwest of its intersection with Route 153] at the intersection with Paper Mill Road, Route 46114 and Stenton Avenue Route 67049** thence northwesterly through **the City of Philadelphia**, Springfield and Whitemarsh Townships to a point of road intersection about .7 of a mile northwest of Williams Station; thence northeasterly through Whitemarsh Township for a distance of about .3 of a mile to a point of road intersection; thence northwesterly through Whitemarsh and Whitpain Townships, via Sandy Hill, to a point of road intersection about .7 of a mile southwest of Bluebell; thence northeasterly through Whitpain Township to a point on Route 197 near Station 634, in Montgomery County, a distance of about **[4.9] 6.3** miles.

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Route 46114. Beginning at a point on the Philadelphia - Montgomery County Line about .2 of a mile southeast of its intersection with Route 153; thence northeasterly through Springfield Township, **[and crossing] to Route 197 at [Five Points] Enfield [to a point on State Aid Application 3961 near Station 149 at about .4 of a mile southeast of Oreland Station]** in Montgomery County, a distance of about **[2.8] 1.9** miles.

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Section 2. (a) The changes in Route 46114 made by this act shall take effect immediately.

(b) The changes in Route 46086 made by this act shall take effect upon completion of the construction of a box culvert on Stenton Avenue in accordance with standards established by the Department of Transportation pursuant to an agreement between the department and Springfield Township.
