## AN ACT

SB 1276

Amending the act of June 1, 1933 (P.L.1172, No.290), entitled "An act establishing certain streets in boroughs and incorporated towns as State highways, and providing for their construction and maintenance at the expense of the Commonwealth," deleting a route in Quakertown Borough, Bucks County.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. As much as relates to Route 09167 in section 2, act of June 1, 1933 (P.L.1172, No.290), referred to as the Borough State Highway Law, added June 25, 1937 (P.L.2279, No.440), is deleted as follows:

Section 2. The streets taken over under the authority of this act are situate and described, as follows:

## Quakertown Borough

[Route 09167. Extending Route 09167.-Beginning at a point on the Richland Township-Quakertown Borough line; thence over Main Street to an intersection with Routes 386 and 09086, at Main and Broad Streets, in the borough of Quakertown, Bucks County, a distance of about 0.48 of a mile.]

Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
