## AN ACT

HB 649

Amending the act of May 5, 1927 (P.L.787, No.408), entitled "An act establishing certain public roads as State highways, and providing for their construction and maintenance at the expense of the Commonwealth," changing a route in Lancaster County.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. As much as relates to Route 649 in section 1, act of May 5, 1927 (P.L.787, No.408), entitled "An act establishing certain public roads as State highways, and providing for their construction and maintenance at the expense of the Commonwealth," is amended to read:

Section 1. Be it enacted, &c., That the following various sections of public roads shall respectively be adopted by the Commonwealth as State highways, to be constructed and maintained at the expense of the Commonwealth under the provisions of present or future laws governing main State highways, that is to say:

Six hundred and forty-nine. [**Commencing in Marietta, Lancaster County, at an intersection with State highway route number two hundred and eighty; and running thence] *Beginning at the Marietta Borough - East Donegal Township line, and extending* in a northerly direction to Mt. Joy *Borough*, and intersecting with State highway route number one hundred and twenty-nine.**

Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
