AN ACT

HB 101

Amending the act of June 22, 1931 (P.L.594, No.203), entitled "An act establishing certain township roads as State highways; authorizing their construction, maintenance, and improvement under certain conditions and restrictions; limiting the obligation of the Commonwealth in the construction of certain structures located on such highways; conferring certain powers upon the Department of Highways and local authorities, persons, associations and corporations for sharing the cost of the maintenance and construction of such highways; and making an appropriation to carry out the provisions of said act," amending and adding routes in Susquehanna Township, Dauphin County.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. As much of section 23 as relates to Route 22023, act of June 22, 1931 (P.L.594, No.203), referred to as the Township State Highway Law, is amended and a route is added to read:

Section 23. The township roads to be taken over, under the provisions of this act, in the COUNTY OF DAUPHIN, are those situate and described as follows:

* * *

Route 22023. Beginning at a point in Susquehanna Township on the eastern boundary line of the City of Harrisburg; thence northerly through Susquehanna Township to a point intersecting [Route 22006 about one and one-half miles west of the Susquehanna-Lower Paxton Township Line, in Dauphin County, a distance of about 3.74 miles.] *Route 22084, in Dauphin County, a distance of about 0.659 mile. Also, that portion of Crooked Hill Road that constitutes the bridge over Route 1005, located slightly north of the intersection of Route 22084 (Elmerton Avenue) and Crooked Hill Road, in Susquehanna Township, Dauphin County.*

* * *

Route 22084. Beginning at the intersection of former Route 22023 (Crooked Hill Road) and Elmerton Avenue, thence in an easterly direction to the intersection of Route 22022 (North Progress Avenue) a distance of 1.8 miles in Susquehanna Township, Dauphin County.

Section 2. This act shall take effect as follows:

(1) Those provisions relating to Route 22084 shall take effect immediately.

(2) Those provisions relating to Route 22023 shall take effect immediately upon the completion of improvements to Crooked Hill Road as set forth in correspondence from Susquehanna Township to the Department of Transportation, dated March 14, 1980, as agreed to by the department and the township.
