Amending the act of June 3, 1937 (P.L.1225, No.316), entitled "An act concerning game and other wild birds and wild animals; and amending, revising, consolidating, and changing the law relating thereto," authorizing the suspension of hunting privileges of persons failing to pay a penalty or honor a citation.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. The act of June 3, 1937 (P.L.1225, No.316), known as "The Game Law," is amended by adding a section to read:

Section 315.1. Suspension.—The commission in the manner provided in section 315 for revocation of licenses may suspend the hunter's license or deny a license (i) for failure to pay a fine for a violation of this act or until such a fine is imposed and fully paid, and (ii) during the time a citation is given and the recipient of the citation responds to it.

Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
