HB 1992

Amending the act of February 1, 1966 (1965 P.L.1656, No.581), entitled "An act concerning boroughs, and revising, amending and consolidating the law relating to boroughs," granting additional powers to the civil service commission relating to the scheduling of applicants' physical examinations.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 1189, act of February 1, 1966 (1965 P.L.1656, No.581), known as "The Borough Code," is amended to read:

Section 1189. Physical Examination.—All applicants for examination shall undergo a physical examination, *either before or after the written examination*, which shall be conducted under the supervision of a physician appointed by the commission. No person shall be eligible for appointment until such physician certifies that the applicant is free from any bodily or mental defect, deformity or disease that might incapacitate him for the discharge of the duties of the position desired.

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
