HB 2081

Amending the act of May 23, 1945 (P.L.913, No.367), entitled, as amended, "An act relating to and regulating the practice of the profession of engineering; including civil engineering, mechanical engineering, electrical engineering, mining engineering, chemical engineering, surveying and constituent parts and combinations thereof as herein defined; providing for the licensing and registration of persons practicing said profession, and the certification of engineers in training, and the suspension and revocation of said licenses, registrations and certifications for violation of this act; prescribing the powers and duties of the State Registration Board for Professional Engineers, the Department of State and the courts; prescribing penalties; and repealing existing laws," exempting certain activities from licensure and registration.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 5, act of May 23, 1945 (P.L.913, No.367), known as the "Professional Engineers Registration Law," amended December 13, 1979 (P.L.534, No.120), is amended by adding a subsection to read:

Section 5. Exemption from Licensure and Registration.—* * *

(i) *The writing of deed descriptions.*

Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
