Repealing the act of January 9, 1964 (Sp.Sess., 1963 P.L.1432, No.2), entitled "An act fixing the number of Senators in the General Assembly of the Commonwealth; apportioning the State into senatorial districts as provided by the Constitution; providing for the election of and the terms of office of the present and future elected Senators and repealing inconsistent laws."

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. The act of January 9, 1964 (Sp.Sess., 1963 P.L.1432, No.2), entitled "An act fixing the number of Senators in the General Assembly of the Commonwealth; apportioning the State into senatorial districts as provided by the Constitution; providing for the election of and the terms of office of the present and future elected Senators and repealing inconsistent laws," is repealed.

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
