SB 398

Amending the act of May 1, 1933 (P.L.103, No.69), entitled "An act concerning townships of the second class; and amending, revising, consolidating, and changing the law relating thereto," increasing an expense allowance.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 612 of the act of May 1, 1933 (P.L.103, No.69), known as The Second Class Township Code, reenacted and amended July 10, 1947 (P.L.1481, No.567) and amended April 6, 1980 (P.L.98, No.36), is amended to read:

Section 612. Expenses and Mileage.—The expenses allowed the delegates attending the annual meeting may be in an amount not exceeding **[seventy-five] ninety** dollars per day for each delegate for not more than four days including the time employed in traveling thereto and therefrom, together with mileage going to and returning from such meeting.

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
