Amending Title 66 (Public Utilities) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, providing for the metering of electricity supplied to volunteer fire companies and nonprofit senior citizen centers; and prohibiting the use of coal mined in foreign countries by certain utilities.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

- Section 1. Title 66 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding sections to read:
- § 1501.1. Certain utilities prohibited from using foreign coal.
- (a) General rule.—No public utility which provides electricity or heat to a State-owned facility shall use coal mined in a foreign country for the purpose of generating electricity or providing heat.
- (b) Definition.—As used in this section the phrase "State-owned facility" means a building owned by the Commonwealth or any agency or authority of the Commonwealth.
- § 1511. Electricity supplied to certain organizations.

Any public utility company supplying electric service shall, upon application, permit a volunteer fire company or a nonprofit senior citizen center to elect to have its electric service rendered pursuant to a rate schedule which provides equivalent charges for such service as residential rates upon execution of a contract for a minimum term of one year.

Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
