Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, providing for special plates for recipients of the Purple Heart; and imposing limitations on certain reduced registration recipients.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:

§ 1346. Special plates for recipients of Purple Heart.

Upon application of any person who is a recipient of the Purple Heart, the department shall issue to such person a special registration plate designating the vehicle so licensed as belonging to a person who is a recipient of the Purple Heart. A severely disabled veteran, as described in section 1342(a) (relating to veteran plates and placard), who is qualified to receive a plate under this section may also elect to receive a placard under section 1342(b). The special registration plate may be used only on one passenger vehicle or one other vehicle with a registered gross weight of not more than 9,000 pounds.

Section 2. Section 1901(d) of Title 75 is amended to read:

§ 1901. Exemption of entities and vehicles from fees.

* * *

- (d) Limitations.—
- (1) Vehicles titled and registered under the provisions of this section shall be operated and used exclusively for the purpose for which the vehicles were entitled to the exemptions from fees.
- (2) Only one passenger vehicle or one other vehicle with a gross weight or registered gross weight of not more than 9,000 pounds may be registered to any person under the provisions of subsection (b)(4) and subsection (c)(16) [and (17)], (17), (18) and (19).

Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
