## AN ACT

HB 188

Prohibiting the use of certain buildings for political fundraising events; and providing a penalty.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

- Section 1. Prohibited use of Governor's and Lieutenant Governor's Mansions and certain public buildings.
  - (a) General rule.—It is unlawful to employ or use the facilities of:
  - (1) the official residence of the Governor of the Commonwealth, the Governor's Mansion, located in the City of Harrisburg; or
  - (2) the official residence of the Lieutenant Governor of the Commonwealth, the Lieutenant Governor's Mansion, located at Fort Indiantown Gap;

for the purpose of holding a political fundraising event.

- (b) Funds returned.—Funds raised upon the behalf of a candidate or committee in violation of the provisions of subsection (a) shall be reimbursed to the contributor.
- (c) Penalty.—A person who knowingly and intentionally violates this act commits a summary offense and shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of \$1,000.

Section 2. Effective date.

This act shall take effect immediately.
