Amending the act of March 4, 1970 (P.L.128, No.49), entitled "An act granting to the Governor of the Commonwealth the sole authority for regulating the display of the flag of the United States from any public ground or building and from any ground or building of certain other institutions," further directing the Governor to display the official POW/MIA flag from a flag pole in Soldiers' Grove.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 1 of the act of March 4, 1970 (P.L.128, No.49), entitled "An act granting to the Governor of the Commonwealth the sole authority for regulating the display of the flag of the United States from any public ground or building and from any ground or building of certain other institutions," is amended by adding a subsection to read:

Section 1. * * *

(c) In addition to any other powers or duties imposed by this section, the Governor shall require the Department of General Services to display continuously from a flag pole in "Soldiers' Grove," as defined in the act of October 30, 1987 (P.L.375, No.75), entitled "An act providing for the designation of certain trees and land on the grounds of the State Capitol in Harrisburg as 'Soldiers' Grove' in honor of war veterans; imposing duties upon the Department of General Services; and making an appropriation," the official POW/MIA flag until all POW's and MIA's return or are accounted for.

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
